

Telecon with Mr. Chick Lawson on 9/24/96

Mr. Chick Lawson attended a meeting with Mr. Dale Allen, Ms. Lynn Calver and Mr. John Haverty in September 1994. They were discussing workman's compensation for an employee that was hurt in August. Mr. Lawson thought that the employee received a dose and Mr. Allen said very emphatically (making gestures with his hand) that he would prove that the employee received a "0" dose.

It was in the January/February time frame that Mr. Lawson found out about doses being lowered. Mr. Lawson requested the information from Mr. Lee Fink. While Mr. Lawson was working at the drive thru gate, Mr. Fink was passing through and said he had received the request. Mr. Fink verbally told Mr. Lawson that he would not get "squat". Mr. Fink said he lied about lowering the dosimeter reading and that he would bury the report so deep that could not be found. Mr. Fink said he did not have to give out any information because they were a private company and not bound by government regulations, and were not obligated to respond to his letter. Mr. Lovelin was present and heard what Lee said.

Mr. Lawson said a manager asked Mr. Mike Smith to change the record. Mr. Lawson said that someone has the disk that changed the record from 0 to 26. Mr. Lawson thinks that records for other individuals were changed at the same time (Mr. Paul Walton, Ms. Shirley Workman and Mr. Susan Brown). They started destroying hard copy records.

Mr. Lawson said that Mr. Cyril Berlin changed the records back to what they were under someone's direction. Mr. Lawson said that Mr. Rick Dively knows what was going on. While Mr. Lawson was in a training class with Mr. Dively, Mr. Dively said he didn't do it that Mr. Smith did.

Mr. Charlie Cox got access to portions of the investigation report and said that they were changed for a court case. Mr. Lawson said there were two versions of the report, one was short and the other was approximately 41 pages. Mr. Don Butler was the main investigator.
