ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO OPEN A MISCELLANEOUS PROCEEDING FOR
THE FILING OF ELK RIVER SPILL CLAIMS

It appeared to the Court that the costs of administration can be reduced and the ease of noticing improved in this case if the Clerk is permitted to open a separate miscellaneous proceeding for the filing of Elk River Spill claims separately from claims of other creditors of Freedom Industries, Inc.. It is therefore

ORDERED that the Clerk is hereby directed to open a miscellaneous proceeding styled: Freedom Industries, Inc. for Filing of Elk River Spill Claims, Case No. 2:14-mp-20017. Furthermore, the Court directs the Clerk to identify all previously filed proofs of claim in this case which are based upon the January 9, 2014 Elk River Spill, and transfer such claims to the Claims Register in the aforementioned miscellaneous proceeding. After entry of this Order, all subsequent claims filed which are based upon the Elk River Spill shall be filed in 2:14-mp-20017.

It is further ORDERED that, with the exception of the claims described above, all pleadings, motions and documents shall continue to be filed in Bankruptcy Case No. 2:14-bk-20017.

It is further ORDERED that any claimant who files their claim in the above Miscellaneous Proceeding and who also wants to receive notices under FRBP 2002 must file a Request for Notices in Bankruptcy Case No. 2:14-bk-20017 that includes a full name and address.

It is further ORDERED that at the time Case No. 2:14-bk-20017 is ready to close, the Clerk shall transfer all claims from 2:14-mp-20017 to 2:14-bk-20017 to allow the case to be archived in the normal manner.
