

Two major components of the Stormwater Program

Regulatory	Infrastructure
<p>1. Public Education and Outreach: <i>Providing materials/events to educate the public about the actions they can take to reduce or eliminate stormwater pollution.</i></p> <p>2. Public Involvement: <i>Getting the public involved in the stormwater program.</i></p> <p>3. Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Program: <i>A codified program that inspects and removes illicit and illegal discharges into the storm sewer system.</i></p> <p>4. Sediment and Erosion Control Program: <i>A codified program that addresses sediment pollution at construction sites. Includes a review, inspection, and enforcement of this program.</i></p> <p>5. Stormwater Management at new development and re-development program: <i>A codified program that requires stormwater management controls at new development and re-development sites. Includes a review, inspection, and enforcement of this program.</i></p> <p>6. Good Housekeeping at municipal facilities. <i>Maintaining our own facilities in a way that reduces or eliminates stormwater pollution.</i></p> <p>7. Record keeping of all activities. <i>Annual report of activities goes to WVDEP.</i></p>	<p>1. Inspection of storm system: <i>Field crews that physically inspect catch basins, pipes, and other storm system structures for an assessment of problems. Also, respond to citizen complaints about possible problems.</i></p> <p>2. Routine maintenance of storm system: <i>Remove dirt, leaves, debris from catch basins and pipes – to increase the capacity. Also, perform minor repairs to any storm system structure.</i></p> <p>3. Replacement and major repairs of storm system: <i>Replacement or repair of crushed pipes, broken catch basins, grates, fixing sinkholes resulting from storm system pipes that have collapsed.</i></p> <p>4. Capital improvement projects: <i>New storm sewers or major replacements and relocation of storm lines, or separation of sanitary and storm. Including the engineering and design of the capital improvement projects.</i></p>
